

Good Works Race Instructions



Set out the Good Works Race sheets on a table along with the items needed to complete the “good work”. Time each child from start to finish. Child with the fastest time wins.

Give drink to the thirsty like St. Therese—use a cup and a pitcher with water. Child pours water into the cup.

Feed the hungry like St. Elizabeth—use a basket and either some toy foods or some buns or individually packed items. Child places food items in basket.

Teach the faith like St. Patrick—Use shamrock page provided by Cascia Books. Cut along the dotted lines. Child puts pieces together like a puzzle.

Clothe the naked like St. Martin of Tours—Child puts clothes on a doll.

Give to the poor like St. Nicholas—child puts coins into a little sack or container

Help build the Church like St. Francis—Use wooden blocks (or whatever you have) to build a small church.

Pray for the living and the dead—Child kneels down and prays the prayer on the sheet, or else a Hail Mary or Glory Be, some little prayer they know well.
